



Net Lake: Quick Facts

- Net Lake is located on the east side of Hwy.
 11 just north of the town of Temagami in the District of Nipissing
- co-ordinates: Lat. 47° 06' 24" Long. 79°
 46' 40"
- this long narrow irregular shaped lake connects to Cassels, Thieving Bear and Kanichee Lake
- while the lake reaches maximum depths of 156', the average depth is 28'
- the perimeter of the lake is 64 km (40 miles)
- the surface area is 710 hectares (1,756 acres)
- popular walleye fishing areas include the inflows from Thieving Bear and Kanichee Lakes, the Net Creek inflow, the Highway 11 and the Northland Railway narrows
- there are several spring sanctuary areas
- there is a public boat launch approx. 1 km north of the bridge at the picnic area
- the major fish species include walleye, northern pike lake trout, smallmouth bass, perch and cisco
- Net Lake is located within Fisheries
 Management Zone 11
